## Location

The Boca Raton Resort and Club is now part of the Hilton Family and is among a collection of luxury and resort hotels called Hilton's Prestige Portfolio.

## Travel by Car

**From the South:** Take I-95 North to Hillsboro Boulevard East (Exit 42A). Turn right onto Hillsboro Boulevard, and drive approximately 1 1/2 miles to Federal Highway (U.S.1). Turn left onto Federal Highway (U.S.1), and drive approximately 1 3/4 miles to Camino Real. Turn right onto Camino Real. The Resort entrance is 1/4 mile ahead at the roundabout.

**From the North:** Take I-95 South toward Miami. Take the Palmetto Park Road exit. Take a left onto Palmetto Park Road and continue east until Federal Highway. Turn right onto Federal Highway / U.S.1 South. Go to Camino Real, make a left. The Resort entrance is 1/4 mile ahead at the roundabout.

## Reservations/ Room Rates

Don't miss out! Make your reservations early! For room reservations call 1-800-327-0101 or 561-447-3000 and let them know you are with FEFPA.

The conference room rates are \$115 Villa, \$120 Cloister Room, \$135 Beach Club, \$155 Tower Room, \$165 Tower Junior Suite and \$165 Yacht Club. These special conference room rates will be honored three days before and three days after the conference (July 4 to July 13) if you wish to extend your stay.

All properties will have a \$9 service fee per person per room per day which covers bell staff and luggage handling at arrival and departure and other services. Valet parking will be \$18 per day.
